APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Spacebuster by raumlaborberlin

Berlin-based architecture collective raumlaborberlin is partnering with the Pulitzer Arts Foundation to make their Spacebuster available for community programs across the St. Louis metropolitan area from September 24-27. Applicants must have permission or the ability to obtain proper permitting for the visit, supply their own event equipment, and a small team to help realize the event. Members of the raumlaborberlin collective will deliver the Spacebuster van, unroll the bubble, inflate and secure it, and ensure that it is safely accessible. No furniture, equipment, or monetary funds will be provided by raumlaborberlin or the Pulitzer. Please make sure you meet all the requirements.

Spacebuster applicants must:

- have an interesting idea for a public event
- provide a suitable space for the event, preferably with a bit of shade, accessible with a truck, and approximately 30 x 60 ft (10 x 20m) of flat ground
- have permission to use site or ability to obtain proper permit
- have access to electricity and water
- have 2-4 people available to help set up the Spacebuster before and after the event (fill/empty and arrange water tanks that secure the inflatable space, and roll up bubble)
- have an event coordinator to manage your event from setup to cleanup.
 (neither raumlaborberlin nor the Pulitzer Arts Foundation will be providing event or financial support)
